6. Public Transport

6.1 Commuter parking - it was noted that cars are parking very close to the corner of Regents Close and there is also a problem with commuter parking and school parking on Whyteleafe Hill.

Cllr John Shannon reported he has had no acknowledgment to the long letter sent to Southern - GOVIA re parking at Upper Warlingham station.

SCCllr Sally Marks reported Hillbury Road parking issues went to Highways committee meeting and the decision was made to review this situation. SCCllr Sally Marks has requested a divisional meeting with representation from Highways, District Council and local Parish Councils.

6.2 Update from Chris Kelly, representative on East Surrey Transport Committee.
New Southern franchise

- from September 2009 -2015. Train capacity to be increased by 10%.
- New system of repayment for delayed & cancelled trains to be introduced.
- Canopies at Purley station to be mended.
- Extra late night services on Fridays & Saturdays and extra daytime services on a Sunday to be introduced.
- It was suggested that station parking charge should be reduced for late afternoon, evening parking.
- Bus 407 transferring to Travel London and service to be increased.
- Will be looking at increasing the parking capacity by 1122 spaces particularly looking at Upper Warlingham and Coulsdon South for potential parking expansion.

7. Highways

7.1 Community Gang work

Road sign with crack in it to be looked at. SCCllr Sally Marks suggested reporting this to Rupert Kelley. Tree to be removed from in front of Whyteleafe sign North of village.

7.2 Church Road – No update as Cllr CR absent.

7.3 Whyteleafe Hill gas main replacement works – Residents at the top of Whyteleafe Hill were not informed that work was to commence.

7.4 Highways Working Party. – Cllr JS & Cllr ML met to discuss parking issues in Whyteleafe, they suggested sending a leaflet to all Hillbury Road residents. Cllr Sally Marks suggested a leaflet drop to residents in the Hillbury Road area should wait till after the divisional highways meeting at the start of November.

Church Road parking also discussed, one hour a day parking restriction suggested.
